1. Go to Document>Header and Footer;
2. In the header portion, highlight and delete the Page number box below the ruler;
3. Go to the Footer tab and click the Page button to place it in the footer;
4. Go to the Format menu>Alignment and choose Centered;
5. Click the Options tab and check the box for Show Footer;
6. Click OK.
